- ✓ Visitors to this exclusive venue included the great, good and talented from the time. Celebrity guests included Gilbert & Sullivan, the most talented musicians of their time, Oscar Wilde, one of the most popular playwrights in London and JM Barrie the creator of Peter Pan, who was inspired by D'Oyly Carte's pet crocodile.
- ✓ The D'Oyly Carte Music Festival will recreate the history, culture, and entertainment, originally intended for this exclusive private island, for the local community and visitors from around the world to enjoy.
- ✓ A flotilla of boats will surround the island, the riverbanks will be packed with onlookers and a vibrant and pulsating island will be re-created, for what is hoped will be an annual event.
